Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Making the transition into High School can be quite daunting. To facilitate this process, Reddam's Middle School camps are in the first week of Term 1. This allows students to get to know each other in an informal setting while enjoying the benefits of being out of the city. Students are challenged to attempt activities that take them out of their comfort zones. The sense of achievement resulting in personal growth is wonderful to witness.
